SUBJECT:	Death of Dave Tannenbaum

It is with regret that I advise you of the death of Dave Tannenbaum, secretary/treasurer of the DAV Charitable Service Trust, and past secretary/treasurer of DAV's State Commanders and Adjutants Association. He passed away on February 27, in Tampa, Florida, at the age of 86.

Dave, a service-connected disabled Army veteran, retired as a lieutenant colonel in 1985 after 30 years of service. He served as an artillery officer in both air defense and field artillery assignments. In addition, he had assignments in military intelligence and nuclear weapons billets. His service also included battery, battalion, group and brigade assignments with the Nike Ajax and Nike Hercules surface-to-air missile systems, as well as custodial assignments with several Greek Army artillery units. Staff assignments included duty with the assistant chief of staff for intelligence on the Army staff, the Office of the Inspector General and 7th Army, and his final assignment was with the Defense Nuclear Agency.

Dave was a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College and the Army War College.

He joined DAV in 1986 and became active in his local chapter, Chapter 15 in Manassas, Virginia, and the Department of Virginia. He served as commander of his chapter and was elected adjutant of the Department of Virginia in 1988, serving in that capacity until 2004.

In 1994, Dave was appointed to the board of the DAV Charitable Service Trust and as secretary/treasurer in 2006. He served as secretary/treasurer of DAV's State Commanders and Adjutants Association from 1993 until his appointment as assistant treasurer in 2022.

Dave attended Vanderbilt University and received a bachelor's degree in chemistry in 1958.
