



# DAV National Convention TRAVEL INFORMATION

Note: there are two different airports you can fly into. Each are noted separately with their unique transportation options.

## PHILADELPHIA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (PHL)

### At Philadelphia International Airport (PHL)

\*We recommend booking flights during the dates and times noted below as shuttles will be offered during those periods.

- Located approximately 60 miles from Harrah's Atlantic City.
- This is the airport most travelers will utilize and is serviced by all major airlines.

### Ground Transport Option 1 : Shuttle

DAV is working with a local company to provide affordable shuttles from Philadelphia International Airport to Harrah's Atlantic City during peak travel times. Once you have registered for the convention at [dav.org/events/2023-national-convention](http://dav.org/events/2023-national-convention) you will receive a confirmation email with instructions and the link to reserve your shuttles. All shuttle arrangements must be made in advance of arrival at Philadelphia International Airport and before **July 17**. After retrieving luggage, proceed to the Baggage Claim Area, look for DAV National Convention Staff for next steps.

#### Shuttles from Philadelphia International (PHL) to Harrah's Atlantic City

**\$75 per person**

<b>Wednesday, Aug. 2</b>	Shuttles will depart at 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. ONLY
<b>Thursday, Aug. 3</b>	Shuttles will depart every hour from 10 a.m.–6 p.m.
<b>Friday, Aug. 4</b>	Shuttles will depart every hour from 10 a.m.–6 p.m.

#### Shuttles from Harrah's Atlantic City to Philadelphia International (PHL)

**\$75 per person**

Depart from Harrah's Atlantic City no less than 3 hours prior to your flight's departure and should be at the airport 2 hours prior to flight's departure.	
<b>Tuesday, Aug. 8</b>	Shuttles will depart every hour from 6 a.m.–4 p.m.
<b>Wednesday, Aug. 9</b>	Shuttles will depart every hour from 4 a.m.–2 p.m.

### Ground Transportation Option 2: Rideshare

Transportation to and from Philadelphia International Airport to Harrah's Atlantic City.

**Lyft:** Approximate cost \$115–\$270. \*Fares based on availability/time of day/size of car.

**Uber:** Approximate cost \$119–\$267. \*Fares based on availability/time of day/size of car.

# ATLANTIC CITY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (ACY)

## At Atlantic City International Airport (ACY)

**Spirit Airlines** is the primary airline servicing Atlantic City International Airport. \*Please be cautious when booking with Spirit Airline as they charge fees for many of the services and allowances included by most major airlines.

- Located approximately 18 miles from Harrah's Atlantic City.

**American Airlines DOES NOT** fly in and out of Atlantic City International Airport. They fly in and out of Philadelphia International Airport and transport passengers on the **American Airlines Service via Landline Bus Service** to and from Atlantic City International Airport.

### ARRIVAL

Philadelphia International Airport to **American Airlines Service via Landline Bus Service** which then travels to Atlantic City International Airport

**Note: AMERICAN AIRLINES ONLY** flies out of Philadelphia International Airport

<b>Step 1:</b>	Arriving at Philadelphia International Airport, you will be directed to a gate that leads to a American Airlines Service via landline bus service and are then transported to Atlantic City International Airport.
<b>Step 2:</b>	From Atlantic City International Airport, you will collect your bags from baggage claim.
<b>Step 3:</b>	You are responsible for securing one of the choices from the <b>Ground Transportation Option: Rideshare</b> from Atlantic City International Airport to Harrah's Atlantic City.

### DEPARTURE

Rideshare from Harrah Atlantic City to Atlantic City International Airport then board **American Airlines Service via Landline Bus Service** which then travels to Philadelphia International Airport

**Note: AMERICAN AIRLINES ONLY** flies out of Philadelphia International Airport

<b>Step 1:</b>	Travel to Atlantic City International Airport using one of the choices from the <b>Ground Transportation Option: Rideshare</b> list below from Harrah's Atlantic City.
<b>Step 2:</b>	After arriving at the Atlantic City International Airport, proceed to the American Airlines desk to check bags. Then proceed through security the security checkpoint to the designated gate on your ticket to board the American Airline Service via landline bus service to Philadelphia International Airport.
<b>Step 3:</b>	Once you arrive at Philadelphia International Airport, they'll de-board inside the American Airlines terminal (bypassing security) and travelers proceed directly to their connecting flight. <b>Checked bags at Atlantic City International Airport will be transferred by American Airlines to the travelers' final destination as expected.</b>

### Ground Transportation Option: Rideshare

Transportation to and from Atlantic City International Airport and Harrah's Atlantic City.

**Taxi:** Taxis are available from 6 a.m. until 12 a.m. daily. Estimated cost to Harrah's Atlantic City is \$40.

**Lyft:** Approximate cost \$40-\$60.\* Fares based on availability/time of day/size of car.

**Uber:** Approximate cost ranges from \$40-\$60. \* Fares based on availability/time of day/size of car.

## TRAIN TRAVEL

### Traveling on AMTRAK

AMTRAK provides service from all major East Coast destinations including New York, Boston and Washington, DC to the **30th Street Station in Philadelphia**. This station is serviced by AMTRAK. After arriving at 30th Street Station in Philadelphia, you will take the New Jersey Transit which will take you to the Atlantic City Train Station which is located at the Atlantic City Convention Center.

- The **30th Street Station** is located approximately 62 miles from Atlantic City Convention Center.

### Step 1: Take New Jersey Transit

The New Jersey Transit provides service from the **30th Street Station in Philadelphia** to the Atlantic City Convention Center. The next step would be one of the rideshare options below to get to Harrah's Atlantic City. **Estimated cost** from Philadelphia to Atlantic City is **\$10.75 per person** (prices subject to change).

### Step 2: Transport Options Ridesharing

Transportation to and from Atlantic City Convention Center and Harrah's Atlantic City.

**Taxi:** Taxis are available from 6 a.m. until 12 a.m. daily. Estimated cost to Harrah's Atlantic City is \$14–\$18.

**Lyft:** Approximate cost \$16–\$20.\* Fares based on availability/time of day/size of car.

**Uber:** Approximate cost ranges from \$16–\$20. \* Fares based on availability/time of day/size of car.

## PERSONAL VEHICLE TRAVEL

### Driving a Personal Vehicle

Atlantic City is easily accessible and located within five hours' drive of nearly 1/3 of the nation's population. DAV's negotiated overnight, self-parking rate at Harrah's Atlantic City is \$8.
